National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) is a member driven organization founded in 1942 to serve as the central voice for America's housing industry. Originally known as the Home Builders and Subdividers Division, this NAR affiliate, proposed in 1939, was designed to bring order and lower costs in the home building industry, as well as serve the interests of the public. NAHB consists of over 700 state and local home builder associations (HBA's) that represent the needs of homebuilders, developers, contractors, and business affiliates. Their mission is to ensure safe and affordable housing to all communities while providing professional success to its members. NAHB also works closely with federal, state, and local agencies to analyze policy issues and regulations that impact the housing industry, energy efficiency, and the environment.

#### **SCOPE AND CONTENTS**

The NAHB collection contains committee proceedings and memorandums, the institution's bylaws and code of professional ethics, and Board of Directors meeting minutes. It also includes membership rosters and conference proceedings, as well as course manuals and other educational materials.
