# What Are Some Common Features of CC&Rs in HOAs?

HOA covenants are usually created when a developer forms a community. The developer may attempt to anticipate the community's needs based on their observations and experience. This is why HOA CC&Rs vary from one community to the next. However, when educating a client, real estate professionals can cite some of the following examples:



## PROPERTY MAINTENANCE STANDARDS

This may mean no piles of trash, broken or damaged fencing, or unsightly sheds.



#### **PET RULES**

The HOA may prohibit pets above a certain weight, livestock (such as chickens) and restrictions on certain dog breeds.



#### **PARKING AND GUESTS**

The HOA may not allow parking in the street or oversized guest vehicles like RVs in the driveway. They may also restrict house parties, large celebrations or get-togethers on your property.



### LANDSCAPING RULES

Rules may prohibit flower beds or herb gardens in the front yard. Residents may not be allowed hardscaping elements like fountains, treehouses or swings.
