

Summary

- ❖ Nationally, Sentrilock home showings were up 1% year-over-year. Showings increased in two of the four regions: The Northeast increased (28%), followed by the South with a smaller gain (7%). The Midwest declined (-5%), followed by the West with the smallest drop (-2%).
- The number of cards, a measure of the number of REALTORS® showing homes, increased 1% year over year.
- Showings per card, a measure of the intensity of demand and buyer competition, were flat (0%) and did not increase year over year.

Showings up 1% Y/Y in July

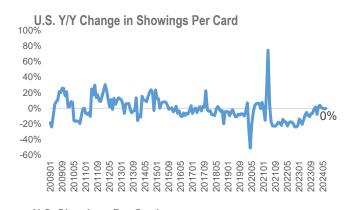
July 2024 U.S. showings were up 1% year-overyear, with 754,338 showings, according to data from SentriLock, LLC., a lockbox company. The pace of showing activity has declined compared to last month, June 2024.

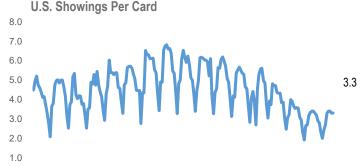
SentriLock Cards Inclined 1% Y/Y

Total U.S. SentriLock cards rose 1% year-overyear to 231,839. SentriLock cards, comprised of SentriKey® and SentriCard®, allow REALTORS® to access the Sentrilock® lockbox and indicate the number of REALTORS® who conduct the showing.

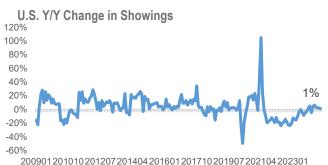
Showings Per Card Showed No Gain 0% Y/Y

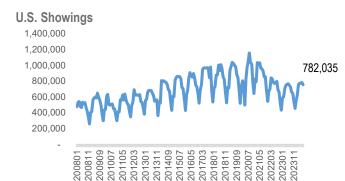
The number of showings per card reflects the strength of buyer interest per listed property. At a national level, showings per card were flat at 0% year over year in July.

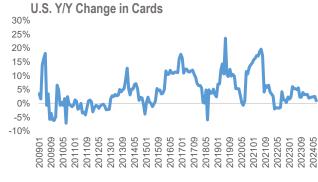


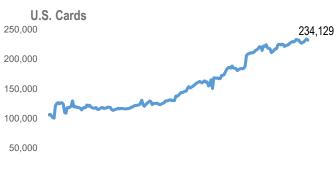

Two of the four Regions Saw Y/Y Showings Increase

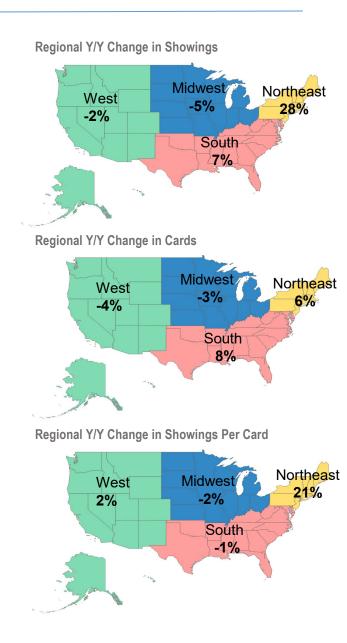
Two of the four regions saw an increase in showings year-over-year in July: The Northeast had the biggest gain (28%), followed by the South (7%). The Midwest had the biggest decline (-5%) followed by the West with the smallest drop (-2%).

Y/Y SentriLock Cards Decreased In Two of the four Regions

Cards were up in the South (8%) and the Northeast (6%) on a year-over-year basis. The West fell (-4 %), followed by the Midwest (-3 %), which had the smallest decline.

Showings Per Card Increased In Two of the Four Regions On A Y/Y Basis

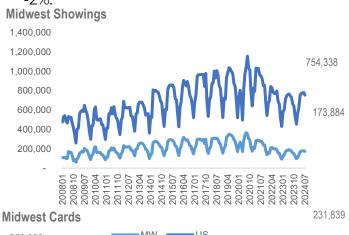
Two of the four regions saw a year-overyear increase in showings per card in July. The Northeast had the biggest incline (21%), followed by the West (2%). The Midwest fell by (-2%) followed by the South region which declined (-1%).

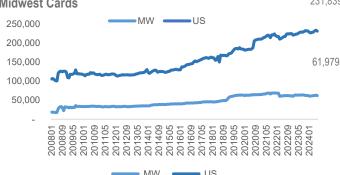


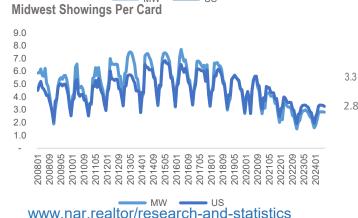

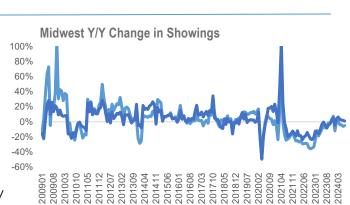
MW Region Showings down -5% Y/Y

Midwest showings were down -5% y/y in July. The July 2024 figure represents -5% change on a year-over-year. The Midwest totaled 173,884 showings. Midwest region Sentrilock cards decreased from last month to 61,979. Showings per card inclined to 2.8. Year-over-year percent change in showings per card decreased by -2%.

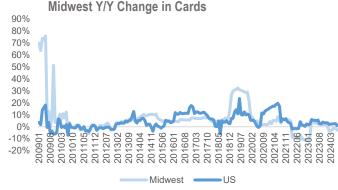


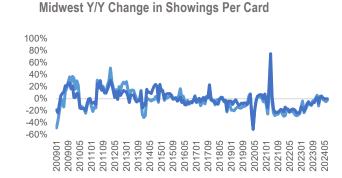

NE Region Showings Increased 28 % Y/Y

Northeast region showings increased 28% year-over-year in July. The Northeast totaled 6,977 showings in July. Northeast Region Sentrilock cards decreased from last month to 3,117. Showings per card was 2.2. Year-over-year percent change in showings per card showed an increase of (21%).

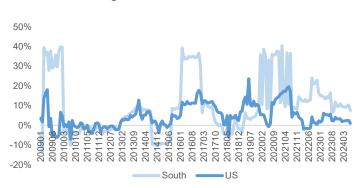
SO Region Showings Inclined 7% Y/Y

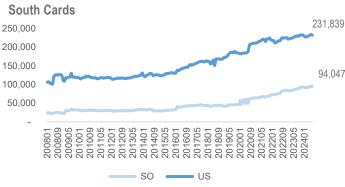
Showings in the South increased in July 19 2024 by 7% from the same period a year 19 ago. The South totaled 312,367 showings in July. South Region Sentrilock cards increased to 95,047. Showings per card totaled 3.3, above the national level. Year-over-year percent change in showings per card was down -1%.

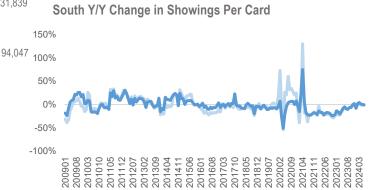


South Y/Y Change in Cards

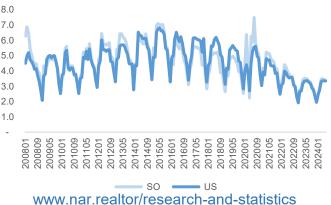


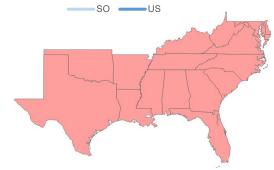






South Showings Per Card

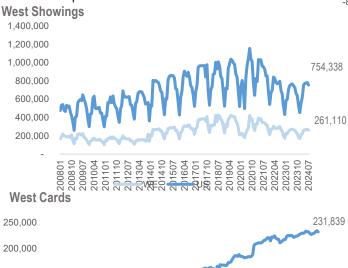




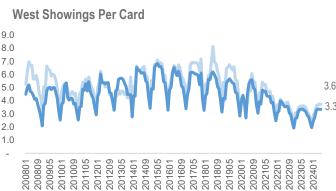

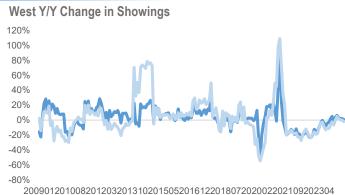
WE Region Showings Flat 0% Y/Y

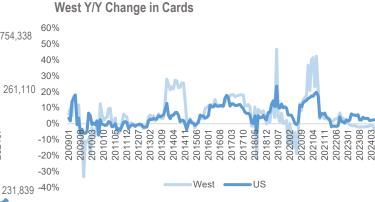
Showings showed no movement of 0% year-over-year in July. The West totaled 261,110 showings in July. West Region Sentrilock cards decreased to 71,696. Showings per card totaled (3.6) and were the highest amongst regions. Y/Y percent change in showings per card was up 2%.

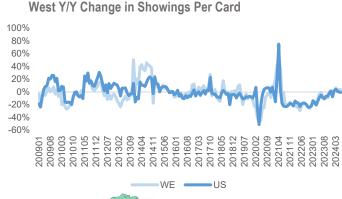

Foot traffic has a strong correlation with future contracts and home sales, so it can be viewed as a peek ahead at sales trends two to three months into the future.

Showings Definition: a scheduled appointment with a REALTOR® where a potential buyer of a property toured a home.

Card Definition: the number of accesses to SentriLock Lockboxes a REALTOR® inserts their SentriCard® into or uses their SentriKey® to gain access to properties.

Showings Per Card Definition: the average showings per card

SentriCard®:contains authorization data that allows you to access lockbox key compartments,

SentriKey®: lockbox system app that contains authorization data that allows REALTORS® to access lockbox key compartments. Most lockbox accesses are via the SentriKey® smart phone app.

The number of showings reflects the number of properties, viewed, the number of potential buyers viewing the property, and the number of views by a potential I buyer on a property. The increase in showings and cards can also reflect increasing market coverage of Sentrilock.
