Adopted and Effective November 13, 2020

Standard of Practice 10-5

REALTORS® must not use harassing speech, hate speech, epithets, or slurs based on race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status, national origin, sexual orientation, or gender identity.



Standard of Practice 10-5 – A Two Step Process

Step 1: Is the speech harassing speech, hate speech, epithets, or slurs?

Step 2: If so, is the speech based on race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status, national origin, sexual orientation, or gender identity?



Adopted and Effective November 13, 2020

The changes are NOT retroactive

Standard of Practice 10-5 and Professional Standards Policy Statement #29 apply **only** to conduct occurring **November 13, 2020** and thereafter.

All other changes go into effect January 1, 2021.

Additional guidance with further explanation provided regarding "harassment", "hate speech", "epithets" and "slurs".



Explanation and Guidance for Standard of Practice 10-5 Examples of Harassment Include, but are not Limited to:

Anti-Harassment Policy

Epithets, slurs or negative stereotyping; threatening, NAR's Code of Conduct and intimidating or hostile acts; denigrating jokes; and the display or circulation of written or graphic material that denigrates or shows hostility toward an individual or group based on a protected characteristic.



Explanation and Guidance for Standard of Practice 10-5

Merriam-Webster's definition of "hate speech"

Speech that is intended to insult, offend, or intimidate a person because of some trait (as race, religion, sexual orientation, national origin or disability).



Explanation and Guidance for Standard of Practice 10-5

Merriam-Webster's definition of "epithet" and "slur"

Epithet: **1a.** a characterizing word or phrase accompanying or occurring in place of the name of a person or thing; **b.** a disparaging or abusive word or phrase.

Slur: **1a.** insulting or disparaging remark or innuendo: ASPERSION, **b.** a shaming or degrading effect: STAIN, STIGMA.



Statement of Professional Standards Policy #29

While REALTORS® are encouraged to follow the principles of the Code of Ethics in all of their activities, aA REALTOR® shall be subject to disciplinary action under the Code of Ethics only with respect to real estate-related all of their activities. and transactions involving the REALTOR®.
